



## Our Work

Established in 1986 by Dr. Biruté Mary Galdikas, Orangutan Foundation International is a nonprofit charity that relies on supporters to continue its important work of protecting endangered orangutans.

We care deeply about conservation *and* animal welfare, and have protected more than 1.5 million acres of rainforest habitat and saved hundreds of captive and orphaned orangutans from death or a dire life in captivity—*giving them a second chance to grow up and be free*. Our work includes:

- Rescue, rehabilitation, and repatriation
- Habitat protection, acquisition, and restoration
- Conservation outreach, education, and research

**Camp Leakey.** OFI supports the longest continuous study of any mammal in the world by one principal investigator and associates at the Camp Leakey study area in Tanjung Puting National Park. The study has been ongoing since 1971.

**Orangutan Care Center and Quarantine.** Established in 1998, the OCCQ was created for rescued and confiscated wild-born, ex-captive orangutans needing medical and other care in preparation for their release back into the wild.

**Habitat Protection.** OFI works in cooperation with the Indonesian government and communities in Borneo to expand national parks, establish reserves, buy land, and replant degraded forest areas to create permanently protected orangutan habitat. Through its forest ranger patrol program, OFI prevents illegal logging, mining, poaching, and palm oil encroachment in protected forest habitat.

**Outreach and Education.** OFI raises awareness about the plight of orangutans and other wildlife species through a wide variety of local and global outreach and education programs.

## You Can Help

### Rampant deforestation is pushing the orangutan closer to extinction every day.

The forests of Indonesia, along with their thousands of plant and animal species, are being destroyed at an alarming rate due to massive illegal logging and clearing for palm oil plantations. The rapid deterioration of tropical forests and the illegal killing and trade of orangutans is causing incalculable losses in terms of biodiversity and is pushing the orangutan ever closer to extinction.

Once numbering in the hundreds of thousands, fewer than 50,000 orangutans are left in the tropical rainforests of Borneo and Sumatra today.

Without intervention orangutan populations could be extinct in the wild in less than two decades. Your help is urgently needed.

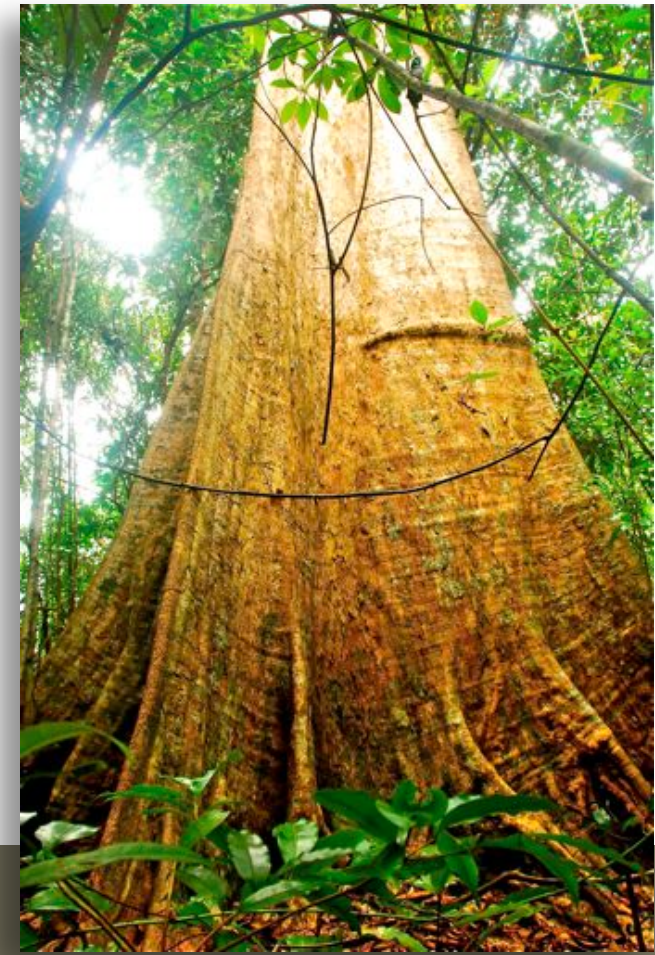
# Help us protect critical orangutan habitat

Your support is urgently needed to help **Orangutan Foundation International (OFI)\*** raise **\$2.4 million** to purchase and permanently protect more than 2,500 hectares (6,000 acres) of prime orangutan habitat in Central Kalimantan (Indonesian Borneo). Known as the *Orangutan Legacy Forest*, this vast, biologically-rich forest is home to hundreds of orangutans and other endangered wildlife species. Yet, like so much of Borneo's forestland it is currently at risk of being clear-cut and converted to palm oil agriculture—a monoculture in which few if any wild species can survive. Without OFI's intervention, this forest habitat will be lost forever.

The *Orangutan Legacy Forest* is part of a larger OFI plan to purchase and protect a network of parcels of primary and secondary lowland forest located between Tanjung Puting National Park, Lamandau Reserve, and the Pasir Panjang Village Forest. OFI is creating a province-wide system of contiguous, biologically-intact nature reserves, parks, corridors, and protected areas, which together will help provide essential habitat to ensure the long-term conservation of the endangered orangutan in our region.

Your generous donation will ensure the permanent protection of the *Orangutan Legacy Forest*, keeping wild orangutans safe and creating a much-needed sanctuary for the release of rehabilitated orangutans back to the wild. **Let this be your legacy!**
