Protecting critical orangutan habitat

OFI Australia recently funded the purchase of another 22 hectares of primary peat swamp rainforest adjacent to the OFI Care Centre. This precious forest land is vital for the population of orangutans who live there and will now be protected from the threat of urban development and palm oil plantations.

We are so relieved we could secure this land as palm oil companies are very competitive and keen to obtain any forest land that is left.

Thank you to our supporters for helping us to purchase and protect this vital piece of orangutan habitat. To save orangutans we must protect their forest home!



Care Centre Hospital receives essential supplies



When orphaned, injured or displaced orangutans come to the OFI Care Centre they are often physically, mentally and emotionally wounded. Many infants suffer from injuries received when their mothers were killed, and other rescued orangutans often arrive severely wounded, many times they are also riddled with bullets.

While some orangutans may just require a quick health check, others require long-term medical and intensive care that may last for some years. The OFI veterinary team work around the clock to ensure the orangutans, sun bears and all other species at our Care Centre receive the best possible medical care. We are so proud to support their vital work.

OFI Australia recently purchased and installed much needed equipment for the Care Centre Hospital, including:

- A new operating table with electronic hydraulics.
- New operating theatre lights.
- An electrosurgical system, vital to stop excessive bleeding during surgery.
- A state-of-the-art digital multimedia microscope with a high-resolution camera.

We have also provided funding for another years' supply of soy milk as most orangutans are lactose intolerant, along with the worming medication that needs to be given four times a year to the orangutans in our care.



All of these items are already making a huge difference to the Care Centre veterinary staff, thanks to your generous donations.
