On this special escorted eco tour, led by Orangutan Foundation International Australia's Founder & President, Kobe Steele, you will enjoy a very personal experience in the Borneo wilderness, and see these wonderful animals.

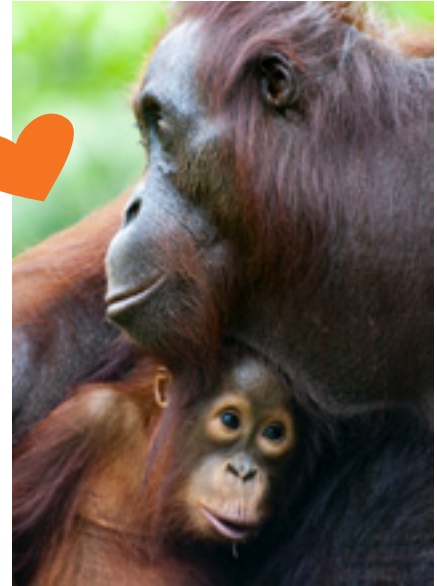
You will spend time along river ways and walking through the forest looking at some of the most amazing wildlife on the planet, including proboscis monkeys, Bornean bearded pigs and hornbills.

You will visit the world famous Camp Leakey, and witness firsthand the amazing work of Dr Birute Mary Galdikas.

You will have the privilege to meet orangutan infants at the Orangutan Foundation International Care Centre, where you can chat with staff who have devoted their lives to the care and rehabilitation of these amazing animals.

You will come away with insights into one of human's closest living relatives and have a wildlife experience that others only dream of.





Itinerary

Day 1: Saturday, 27th April, 2024

You have arrived in Jakarta. You will make your own way to the FM7 Hotel (airport hotel). As people will be arriving at different times throughout the day, your day will be at leisure. You will meet at 5.00pm with Kobe Steele in the hotel for a group briefing.

Accommodation: FM7 Hotel, Jakarta

Day 2: Sunday, 28th April, 2024

Today we will take an early morning flight from Jakarta to Pangkalanbun, Kalimantan. Upon arrival we will proceed by car to Kumai to board traditional klotok boats for a 2 hour cruise up the Sekonyer River to our jungle accomodation. After lunch, we will cruise a short way downstream to Pondok Harapan (feeding station #3).

Accommodation: Rimba Lodge, Tanjung Puting National Park

Day 3: Monday, 29th April, 2024

After an early breakfast, we will cruise upstream to Pondok Tanggui (feeding station #2). Feeding occurs each morning with time afterwards for a gentle walk on the 3km loop track & an excursion further up river in search of proboscis & long tailed macaque monkeys. In the afternoon we will enjoy a canoe trip followed by a visit to the local village.

Accommodation: Rimba Lodge, Tanjung Puting National Park

Day 4: Tuesday, 30th April, 2024

After breakfast, we will cruise upsteam to the tributary "black water" stream that ultimately leads to Camp Leakey (feeding station #1). Here we will witness the afternoon feeding & have time to walk many trails for possible sightings of orangutan.

Accommodation: Rimba Lodge, Tanjung Puting National Park

Day 5: Wednesday, 1st May, 2024

After breakfast, we cruise by klotok back to Kumai and then transfer to the OFI Care Centre near Pangkalanbun, where we will have the opportunity to see dozens of orphaned orangutans at various stages of rehabilitation. We will be fortunate enough to have the staff brief us about the operations at the Care Centre.

Accommodation: Grand Kecubung Hotel, Pangkalanbun

Day 6: Thursday, 2nd May, 2024

We will visit one of the soft release sites for orangutans who have graduated from OFI's rehabilitation program & are earmarked for 'release back into the wild.

Accommodation: Grand Kecubung Hotel, Pangkalanbun

Day 7: Friday, 3rd May, 2024

Today you will take a flight from Pangkalanbun to Jakarta where our trip ends (flight time to be confirmed).

NB - this itinerary is subject to change.

Flight Delays

Domestic flights within Indonesia are subject to delay and/or rescheduling without notice. It is recommended you allow a decent buffer before scheduling your homeward bound flight in case of delays (no less than half a day) as this occurs quite regularly.

In the event your program is delayed or has to be rerouted, you will be liable for any additional costs (eg. accomodation, air tickets etc.) which you must pay in full at the time.

Air tickets on Indonesian domestic/regional airlines are generally non-refundable.

Highlights

- Visit Tanjung Puting National Park, the base of Dr Birute Galdikas, world renowned orangutan expert. Dr Galdikas was mentored by Dr Louis Leakey along with Dian Fossey and Jane Goodall. Camp Leakey, in Tanjung Puting National Park, is the site of the longest continuous study by a principal investigator of any non-human wild animal.
- Visit the OFI Care Centre, normally closed to the general public, where orphaned orangutans are cared for and taught everything they need to know to one day thrive in the wild. This is a rare and unique opportunity to see OFI's rehabilitation and conservation work behind the scenes.
- Walk through the forests of Tanjung Puting National Park with local Dayak guides.
- Cruise the Sekonyer River on a comfortable klotok river boat.
- See proboscis monkeys and magnificent tropical birds in the wild.
- Meet with OFI staff and have a chance to ask questions.
- Visit a local village and understand the ongoing issue of resource management between people and orangutans.
- Stay at a comfortable rustic river eco lodge that was built especially for the Great Apes Conference in 1991.
- Assured multiple orangutan sightings at close proximity.
